



Welcome to Maercker School District 60. Listed below are the *required* State of Illinois health documents for *entry* into Illinois schools. In addition, if your child requires administration of medication during school hours, the district's School Medication Authorization form is required. For children requiring the administration of emergency medication during a life-threatening event, such as *anaphylaxis*, please contact the school nurse. Your child will need additional *emergency medical forms*. If your child has asthma, please submit to the school an *Asthma Action Plan*, provided by your child's physician.

Completed health information is to be returned to the school office by August 1st

Required Health Information by Grade

Students New to Illinois Schools

- **Grade-level** requirements listed below
- **Physical Examination**
 - Must have been completed within one year prior to entry into an Illinois school
 - Must be submitted on the *State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination* form
- **Immunization Record** with *required immunizations* according to grade level entry, as stated below
- **Vision Examination** documented on the *State of Illinois Eye Examination Report* form

Preschool

- **Physical Examination** completed within one year prior to entry into Preschool and documented on the *State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination* form
- **Immunization** record with *required immunizations*:
 1. **DTP**: minimum of 3 doses by 1 year of age and a 4th dose by the 2nd birthday
 2. **Polio**: minimum of 2 doses by 1 year of age and one additional dose by 2nd birthday
 3. **MMR**: 1 dose on or after the 1st birthday
 4. **Varicella (Chicken Pox)**: 1 dose on or after the 1st birthday
 5. **Hepatitis B Series**: 3 doses with last dose being on or after 6 months of age
 6. **HIB**: minimum of 1 dose on or after 15 months of age
 7. **PCV**: minimum of 1 dose on or after 24 months of age

A Mantoux Tuberculin (TB) skin test is strongly recommended and may be required.

Over



Kindergarten (K)

- **Physical Examination** completed within one year prior to entry into Kindergarten and documented on the *State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination* form
- **Immunization** record with *required immunizations*:
 1. **DTaP**: minimum of 4 doses, with the last dose given on or after the 4th birthday
 2. **Polio**: minimum of 4 doses, with the last dose given on or after the 4th birthday
 3. **MMR**: 2 doses, with the first dose given on or after the 1st birthday
 4. **Varicella**: 2 doses, with the first dose given on or after the 1st birthday
- **Dental Examination** submitted on the *State of Illinois Proof of School Dental Examination* form
- **Vision Examination**: submitted on the *State of Illinois Eye Examination Report* form

Second Grade (2nd):

- **Dental Examination** submitted on the *State of Illinois Proof of School Dental Examination* form

Sixth Grade (6th)

- **Physical Examination** completed within one year prior to entry into sixth grade and documented on the *State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination* form
- **Dental Examination** submitted on the *State of Illinois Proof of School Dental Examination* form
- **Immunization Record** with *required immunizations*:
 1. **DTaP**: minimum of 4 doses, with the last dose given on or after the 4th birthday
 2. **Tdap**: must show proof of having received **one** Tdap vaccine
 3. **Polio**: minimum of 4 doses, with the last dose given on or after the 4th birthday
 4. **MMR**: 2 doses, with the first dose given on or after the 1st birthday
 5. **Varicella**: 2 doses, with the first dose given on or after the 1st birthday
 6. **Hepatitis B Series**: 3 dose minimum at required intervals
 7. **MCV**: 1 dose received **on or after** the 11th birthday

State law requires a child to be EXCLUDED from school without the proper immunizations and physical examination.

Low cost immunizations may be obtained through the DuPage County Health Department for children who do not have insurance coverage for immunizations. Students needing financial assistance in obtaining medical exams may call the DuPage County Health Department at (630) 969-7030 for more information.
